Shoreham Airport

Shoreham Airport is at the forefront of general aviation in the UK, and a major base for flying activities on the South Coast. Shoreham is the oldest licensed airfield in the UK and has a beautiful Grade II listed art deco style Terminal Building.

With its friendly stress-free atmosphere, Shoreham Airport offers all the requirements for modern aviation including executive and business travel, as well as excellent conference and meeting facilities.



Le Touquet

Le Touquet has a reputation as the most elegant holiday resort of northern France - the playground of rich Parisians, with many luxury hotels.

The resort was created in 1876 by the owner of the Paris newspaper, '*Le Figaro*'. Then this was an area of wild sand dunes and forest - part of a hunting estate. It became known as "Paris by the sea", and strict building regulations encouraged the most talented architects to create imaginative and innovative developments.

Inland from the beach, the hotels, casino, and expensive villas are spaced out amid acres of woodland, offering every sport imaginable, particularly golf.





Le Touquet Itinerary

- 0815 Guests meet at Shoreham Airport where they will be met by a representative who will escort them to a lounge for refreshments; before their private aircraft departs (everyone is required to bring their passport!)
- 0900 Aircraft departs from Shoreham Airport
- 1045 Flight lands at Le Touquet Airport where you will be met by a local guide who is escorting the group for the day.
- 1100 Coach transfer departs for the beach!
- 1130 A fun couple of hours learning to 'Sand Sail' on 16km of beautiful coastline
- 1400 Arrive at Le Flavio restaurant which is a Le Touquet institution, and long may it last. Founded just after the war, guests are able to sample wonderful French cuisine in luxurious yet relaxed surroundings.
- 1630 Transfer to Perlé de Groseille for a tasting and tour. This is the regional aperitif of the Côte d'Opale
- 1800 Transfer back to Le Touquet airport
- 1845 Flight departs for Shoreham Airport
- 1830 Arrive back at Shoreham Airport



Costs

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Payments

A deposit of 30% of total cost is required upon confirmation. The balance is required based on full occupancy of the aircraft, 8 weeks prior to departure. Repayment for reduced numbers as well as any additional on-site extras will be settled after the event.

Cancellations by the client

If the event is cancelled by the client, the following conditions will apply:

- Cancellation prior to 90 days before departure - Loss of deposit.
- Cancellation between 90 - 30 days before departure - 50% of total projected cost of the event if it had taken place.
- Cancellation less than 30 days before departure - 100% of total projected cost of the event if it had taken place.
- If the event is cancelled completely, at any time, all deposits paid or overdue for payment will be forfeited.

Cancellations due to adverse weather

It is possible that the event will have to be postponed due to adverse weather conditions. Such a decision will be made by the aircraft operator up to 09:00am on the day of travel. After 09:00am on the day of travel the client has the option to wait and continue with the programme, or to cancel and reschedule to another day. If the decision is to cancel the event, the client will be asked to choose another date, departing within 4 weeks - there will be no charges passed on to the client. No compensation will be paid for missed aspects of the day, if departure is delayed.

For our UK programmes to Goodwood, Chewton Glen, Le Manoir etc guests will travel to the venue by road.

Change of departure date

If a client wishes to change the date of the event once the booking is confirmed the following charges will apply: -

Once the booking has been confirmed	£500 charge
Between 28 to 14 days prior to departure	50% of the total event cost
Less than 14 days	100% of the total event cost

Air traffic control

Vantage Point cannot accept any liability for delays caused by air traffic control. The programme for the day will be adjusted to accommodate the changes.

Variation of numbers

Final numbers must be confirmed 14 working days prior to departure. Final reconciliation of the invoice will be made on this basis.



Late return to UK

Arrangements will be made to ensure that you return to your home base airport by the scheduled time. If you choose to delay your return then there may be an additional charge to keep the home base airport open late. For example, Biggin Hill at 2100 hrs.

Exchange Rates

If costs increase due to exchange rate fluctuations, which are beyond the control of Vantage Point, then Vantage Point shall be entitled to vary the costs quoted.

Fuel Surcharges

If there is an increase in fuel surcharges these will have to be passed on to the client as an additional cost.

On Site Extras

If additional services, food or drinks are required on location over and above the inclusions in our arrangements, then these can either be paid directly on site by you, or, invoiced after the event with a 15% charge.

Site Inspection Costs

If you would like us to arrange a site inspection, staff costs are charged at £400 full or part day, plus any additional expenses such as UK travel costs, flights, meals, costs incurred in the destination etc.
